The PLA Autumn Training Day this year will be held in London on Thursday 4 November.

The aim of the day is to provide a topical and practical day's training on some key property issues, focusing on the needs of property litigators. The programme, which is set out below, is designed to complement that of the Annual Conference held in the spring.

We have considered members' feedback, and this year we have sought to deliver a programme that addresses those practical issues that face property litigators on a daily basis. As per last year the speakers will be an all-star cast drawn from the leading property sets rather than all from one chambers as in previous years. Jonathan Seidler QC has kindly agreed once again to continue as Chairman.

The Royal Society of Medicine with its excellent facilities will be the venue once again for a fourth successive year.

There is a special discounted range of attendance fees on offer this year in recognition of the current strain on members' training budgets.

The price of a single place has been lowered to £175 + VAT (from £195 in 2009) and there are further reductions for additional places taken. See below for full details

The fee includes lunch, all refreshments and course papers.

As in previous years, the event will take place on the same day as the AGM and Annual Dinner (both held that evening at The Merchant Taylors' Hall in the City of London) for the benefit of those from outside London. Details for these events are issued separately.
